Code of Ethics

- The artworks in the gallery are sourced from various Aboriginal communities and regions, as illustrated in the map below:



- All the artwork is original and authentic Aboriginal art.
- Certificates of Authenticity are issued upon purchase for works over AUD \$500.
- The art on display has been purchased either directly from the government community art centres, by buying directly from the artists or our associated private art dealers.
- Artists are paid in full at time of purchase unless on consignment. Artists are paid the agreed value for their artworks. This takes into consideration the artist's seniority and artistic status and other tangible indicators such as size and quality of artwork.
- Aboriginal Art Galleries (AAG) sponsors the Aboriginal Benefits Foundations (ABF). A percentage of profit is donated on an annual basis to ABF who help facilitate the improvement of the Aboriginal quality of life.
- We actively promote Aboriginal art and culture in schools and clubs. We instigate cultural learning activities for children and a portion of sales is donated back to the schools.
- We value the uniqueness of the Australian Aboriginal culture and take pride in sharing certain aspects of them with you.
